



DOT Hand Sanitizer Shipping Exceptions

This guidance is limited to ground transportation by motor vehicle only – no air, ocean or rail!

Exception from all DOT hazmat regulations provided all packaging and hazard communication procedures below are met.

Small Packagings (Receptacles, Bottles)

Not >1 gal each receptacle and not >8-gallon total per package

Applies to transport by a common or contract carrier and transport as a private carrier (motor vehicle transport only):

- Exception from all DOT hazmat regulations provided all packaging and hazard communication procedures are met
- Two distinctions between packaging sizes:
 1. Inner packagings NOT EXCEEDING 1-gallon (8-gallon per outer package max total);
 2. Packagings EXCEEDING 1-gallon (8-gallon per package max total); overpacks okay.

Mark the company name and the words **“Sanitizer - Contains Ethyl Alcohol”** or **“Sanitizer -Contains Isopropyl Alcohol”** on each package and overpack (if applicable)



Non-Bulk Packagings (<=119-Gallon Capacity)

> 8-gallon total per package.

Exception from most DOT hazmat regulations provided all outlined packaging and hazard communication guidelines are met including:

- Classification
- Packaging
- Hazard Communication



Identify & classify as follows:

- *UN/ID Number:* UN1987
- *Proper Shipping Name (PSN):* Alcohols, n.o.s.
- *Hazard Class:* 3 (Flammable Liquids)
- *Packing Group (PG):* PG II

Package Requirements:

- DOT or UN-specification packaging meeting PG II performance standards; prepared and closed according to manufacturer’s instructions.
- Maximum net capacity of 119-gallons
- Display Class 3 Flammable Liquid label
- Placarding only for aggregate over 1,000 lbs.

Documentation Requirements:

- Prepare DOT Shipping Paper & Certification
- Emergency Response Guide 127.

Subject to ALL DOT hazmat regulations.

Bulk Packagings

>119-gallon Capacity

Packagings with capacity of greater than 119-gallons.
